 Design renovations for BMS.
- 2022: Complete Phase 1 WHS athletic field project and start Phase 2 WHS athletic field construction. Complete architectural renovations at BMS. Design renovations and additions at WHS.
- 2023 Series 2: Start renovations and additions at WHS. Complete mechanical upgrades at BMS. Design renovations at Upper Elementary
- **2024:** Complete renovations and additions at WHS. Start construction at Upper Elementary. Design renovation work at 2 elementary schools.
- 2025 Series 3: Complete renovations at Upper Elementary. Complete renovation work at 2 elementary schools. Design renovation work at next 2 elementary schools.
- 2026: Complete renovation work at 2 next elementary schools. Design work at the final elementary school.
- 2027 Series 4: Complete renovation work at final elementary school. Design work for BMS and support services building.
- 2028: Complete renovation work at BMS and support services building.

Three-Month Schedule

November

- BP #3: Complete the landscaping and plantings along with the additional handrail.
- BP #5: Graphic Art Addition Wrap-up interior finishes, sitework and paving. Furniture installation and IT to occur in early November with classes to begin in the new graphic art classroom the week of 11/13.
- BP #5: Performing Art Addition Masonry walls, structural steel and roof nailers to be completed to allow the installation of the roofing to occur.
- BP #5: Renovations Continue with renovations of select classrooms on 2nd shift. Will be wrapping up the 3rd group of classrooms by mid-November and starting the 4th group of classrooms. Start demolition of the old graphic art classroom to convert to the new athletics office.
- BP #6: Upper Elementary Complete construction documents and issue the RFP for bids.

December

- BP #5: Graphic Art Addition Complete punch list items.
- BP #5: Performing Art Addition Install temporary enclosures to get the building weather tight and then complete underground MEP and pour interior concrete slabs.
- BP #5: Renovations Continue with renovations of select classrooms on 2nd shift. Will be wrapping up the 4th group of classrooms by mid-December and starting the 5th group of classrooms. Construct new interior partitions and start MEP rough-in for the new athletics office.
- BP #6: Upper Elementary Receive bids from contractors, conduct post bid interviews and provide an update to the BOE on December 19th.

January

- BP #5: Performing Art Addition Start installation of overhead MEP, construct new interior partitions and start painting the masonry walls.
- BP #5: Renovations Continue with renovations of select classrooms on 2nd shift. Will be wrapping up the 5th group of classrooms by mid-January and starting the 6th group of classrooms. Complete construction of interior partitions and start painting the walls along with start installation of acoustic ceilings in the athletics office.
- BP #6: Upper Elementary Award recommendation package to be presented to BOE at January board meeting. Upon approval, contracts to be issued to all contractors and material procurement to start.
