# Non-Homestead 18 Operating Mill Renewal - May 2, 2023 - No School for Students

On Tuesday, May 2, 2023, voters in the Woodhaven-Brownstown School District will be asked to renew the 18 mills assessed on non-homestead property. The non-homestead millage is a very important part of the school district's budget as it represents about \$7.5 million (13.3%) of the district's operating revenue.

Some important items to keep in mind:

- This renewal WILL NOT affect your primary residence
- This renewal ONLY applies to local businesses and industrial and commercial property
- This is a RENEWAL, not an increase
- This renewal directly impacts the district's ability to deliver quality education to our students
- This \$7.5 million cannot be replaced with other funding sources, and state law requires voter approval

Because many of our schools are voting precincts, school will not be in session on Tuesday, May 2, 2023. Please help spread the word - NO SCHOOL ON 5/2/23, and don't forget to vote.



# WHS Names Top 10 for the Class of 2023

Woodhaven High School named the Valedictorian and Salutatorian and its "Top 10" for the Class of 2023. Class rank is based on a point system that consists of 50% GPA and 50% SAT score calculated as follows:  $(GPA \times 400) + (SAT) = Ranking$ . Class ranking is determined after final grades from the 1st semester are calculated, establishing the Top 10 for each graduating class.

A total of 49 students earned the rank of "Senior Scholar", including the Top 10. Senior Scholar status is determined by the following formula:  $SAT (GPA \times 400) + SAT (Totaling 2730 points and above)$ .

Students will be honored at the annual Awards & Honors Night on May 17, 2023.

After a three-year hiatus, Kids Against Hunger returned to the WBSD. Kiwanis Club of Woodhaven sponsored the event on February 11, 2023, at Bates Elementary School.

WBSD 3rd-5th grade students worked with Kiwanis members, school staff and numerous volunteers to pack 20,100 food bags that were distributed to local food pantries. Members of the Varsity Hockey team, the Robotics team and the PHMS Warrior Charity Club also joined in and helped guide the students as they worked. Food bags also got distributed to the U. S. Military, who then flies the bags to countries it provides humanitarian relief.

Students worked in assembly lines to fill the bags, weigh them for international shipping, heat seal the bags closed and then pack them in shipping boxes.

Kids Against Hunger is a non-profit humanitarian organization that provides fully nutritious food to impoverished children and families locally and around the world. The meals provide a stable nutritional base so that families can move from starvation or food insecurity to self-sufficiency. That's the goal of Kids Against Hunger.
