## Jay Vesperman Gets the Nod as WHS Principal



## **Keith Christnagel Named New Athletic Director**




#### **BASEBALL**

What an awesome ride this has been for both teams and a great finish for the seniors!










## Warrior Athletes Shine at the MHSAA Track & Field State Finals

Our Warriors had a great showing the the MHSAA Div. 1 Track & Field state championships on June 2-3rd.


Maya Justice took home state runner up honors in the long jump with an incredible jump of 18-3.25 feet
