The event was well attended and most importantly, the participants had a great time. Thank you to all the participant schools who made Victory Day a huge success for our community.




























Homecoming 2023



















































GSRP is Here!

Spot Light on WHS Senior Samarah Saggers

Great things are happening for WHS senior Samarah Saggers. Not only has Saggers been named as a National Merit Scholarship semi-finalist, she's also in contention for one of Coca Cola's \$20,000 scholarships.

In order for students to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship, they must score in the top one percent of their state. In Michigan, that minimum score was 217 for the Class of 2024. Students must also earn an SAT score of 1400 - 1520 in order to qualify. In addition, students must also:

- 1. Be enrolled as a high school student (traditional or homeschooled), progressing normally toward graduation or completion of high school, and planning to enroll full-time in college no later than the fall following completion of high school;
- 2. Take the PSAT/NMSQT in the specified year of the high school program and no later than the third year in grades 9 through 12;
- 3. Attend high school in the United States, District of Columbia, or U.S. commonwealths and territories; amd/or meet the citizenship requirements for students attending high school outside the United States.

In September, 16,000 students from across the county were chosen as semi-finalists. 15,200 (95%) of this group will be chosen to become finalists and about half or 7,600 will be awarded \$2,500 scholarships and have bragging rights of being a National Merit Scholar.

Saggers is also one of 40 students in the State of Michigan who were chosen as semi-finalists for the \$20,000 Coca Cola Scholarship. Only 1,154 students (about 1.45%) were selected from over 103,800 applicants. Applicants must also demonstrate academic excellence, leadership and service in both school and community activities.

Saggers hopes to major in public policy or cognitive science when she begins her post-secondary education track. She has applied to several universities including, the University of Michigan, Northwestern and Cornell. Saggers credits her mom as being her motivation for applying for the scholarships. She said, "Her hard work and dedication to her endeavors inspires me, and she constantly encourages me to put myself out there and seek opportunities to challenge myself."






