## WHS Welcomes Dawn Izzi, New Assistant Principal


At the end of the 2022/23 school year, WHS found itself in need of a new assistant principal when Mr. Jay Verspman was named principal replacing Mr. Matt Czajkowski who retired.

First and second round interviews took place in July. The decision was ultimately made to hire Mrs. Dawn Izzi, who was approved by the Board of Education at its August 22, 2023 regular meeting.

Izzi comes to the WBSD from Oak Park Preparatory Academy where she served as an assistant principal since 2017. ## **WBSD Offers Two Early Childhood Programs**

The Woodhaven-Brownstown School District believes early childhood education, from birth to five years old is a foundational phase in a child's life, laying the groundwork for their cognitive, social, emotional, and physical growth. It is during these years that children acquire essential skills and knowledge that will help shape their perspectives, abilities, interactions, and habits throughout their lives. Below we have listed two very important new Early Childhood Initiatives that we will be adding to our district.

#### **Early On Expansion**

Early On is Michigan's system for helping families of infants and toddlers, birth to age three who have developmental delay(s) and/or disabilities. Early On supports and partners with families to promote the development of their infants and toddlers in developmental areas, such as:

- physical (reaching, rolling, crawling, and walking)
- cognitive (thinking, learning, solving problems)
- a communication (talking lietaning understanding gesturing)

- social-emotional (feeling secure, able to calm, playing with others)
- self-help (eating, dressing)

Early On partners with families, using their daily routines to work on supporting the growth and development of their babies.

During the first three years of life, a baby's brain grows and changes dramatically. Early On emphasizes early identification and early referral to minimize delays and maximize developmental outcomes. Understanding your child's development may help you recognize if your child needs a referral. #### Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)

The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is Michigan's state-funded preschool for four-year-old children. Families qualify for free preschool based on annual income guidelines.

The Woodhaven-Brownstown School District is offering up to two GSRP classrooms during 2023-24 school year to those who qualify. To learn more about the GSRP program, please review the <u>GSRP FAQ</u> (link below).
