Dear Woodhaven-Brownstown School District Parent,

On May 4, 2021, the Woodhaven-Brownstown School District is asking voters to consider a \$144 million bond proposal, with a **zero-tax-rate increase**, to improve facilities at all schools, with a focus on our elementary and middle schools. The bond program will focus on facility improvements, technology and equipment, program enhancements, and athletic field, playground, and site improvement.

Facility Improvements: Replace and improve outdated building systems and equipment to promote energy efficiency and protect our District's assets.

Technology & Equipment: Continue to update technology and equipment for learning environment of today and into the future.

Program Enhancements: Expansions to foster safe student learning environments and community engagement.

Athletic Field, Playground, and Site Improvements: Facilities and site improvements that promote District-wide health, safety, and wellness.

As a District that proudly serves more than 5,500 students, the bond program would give our schools the funds needed to not only preserve the WBSD as a *Destination for Excellence*, but also enable us to continue our growth and improvement.
