Dear Woodhaven-Brownstown School District Community,

At 7:14 a.m. this morning, I received notification that the Wayne County Health Department (WCHD) would be rescinding their mask mandate, effective at 8:00 a.m. This is counter to their media advisory of February 11, 2022, titled “Mask Mandates in Wayne County Anticipated to be Rescinded by February 28”, and which indicated *The Wayne County Health Department ... will provide updates to enable schools to plan accordingly.*

Given the timing of the WCHD announcement and its complete disregard in allowing staff, parents, and students to, in fact, plan accordingly, the Woodhaven-Brownstown School District will continue to ask students, staff, and visitors to utilize face masks through the end of the school day today, February 17, 2022.

The WBSD will, after today, utilize the approach it had planned to implement before the WCHD mask mandate was put in place in August 2021; mask use for students, staff, and visitors within school buildings, while encouraged, will be optional.

At this time, the federal transportation mask mandate is still in effect. Therefore, masks continue to be required on all forms of district transportation/school buses. We will let you know when that changes.
