Breakfast and Lunch Meal Distributions

On September 1, 2020, the USDA extended the free breakfast and lunch program that had expired on August 31, 2020. As of now, the extension is expected to run to June 30, 2021 or as long as funds are available.

ALL students attending in-person instruction in the WBSD are now eligible, on a daily basis, for a free breakfast and lunch.

We are also offering free breakfast and lunches for our remote learners as well, per the distribution schedule below:

Meal distribution takes place on Mondays. Seven (7) days' worth of breakfasts and lunches may be picked up at Bates Elementary School, Brownstown Middle School and Woodhaven High School from 3:15 p.m. – 5:15 p.m.
