^{**}There are no state approved scores related to these assessments. Subject area and qualifying scores are specific to an Institution of Higher Education (IHE). It is best to contact the IHE to see what scores they accept as a qualifying score for the desired dual enrollment course.

Dual Enrollment Checklist and Agreement

Dual Enrollment Checklist:

- 1. Student completes Woodhaven-Brownstown School District Dual Enrollment Eligibility Form
- 2. Student completes college application for a Dual Enrollment Student for the institution s/he would like to attend
- 3. Student prints course description of the course they are requesting to take
- 4. Student brings application and course description to school counselor for approval/signature
- 5. Counselor takes the signed forms to the principal for approval and emails forms to the finance director
- 6. Once approved student is contacted
- 7. Student enrolls at the post-secondary institution as a dual enrollment student and is responsible for all additional paperwork for registration and/or withdrawals.
 - a. If student decides not to take a dual enrollment course but has already registered, it is their responsibility to withdraw before the drop date at the post-secondary institution. Student is responsible for any fees incurred.

Signatures below confirm the following:

- Woodhaven Brownstown School District accepts responsibility for payment of tuition and fees as outlined in Dual Enrollment Legislation and per pupil funding. The student is responsible for any costs beyond per pupil funding allocation.
- Student and parent/guardian has read and agrees to follow the Woodhaven Brownstown School District dual enrollment guidelines/checklist.
- If named student above does not successfully complete the academic class indicated the student/parent/guardian agrees to reimburse the Woodhaven Brownstown School District by the close of the current school year for all payments made to the college.
- In the case of an unauthorized withdrawal from the institution, student's grade will reflect as a failing grade on the Woodhaven transcript.
- Student is responsible for registering and/or withdrawing at the post-secondary institution.
- The final grade issued by the institution will be reported as the final grade on the Woodhaven transcript if high school credit is elected.
- Woodhaven-Brownstown School District to has student's permission to discuss my course progress at the higher education post-secondary institution.
